Places to Visit:

Places of historical Importance:

1. India Gate – Built in Memory of Indian Soldiers
2. Red Fort or Lal Quila in Hindi; Lal means Red and Quila means Fort)
3. Old Fort or Purana Quila ( you can now guess what “Purana” means)
4. Humayuns Tomb – Not much to see here but for young couples trying to find some privacy.
5. Qutub Minar

6. Jantar Mantar – There is not much to see here.

7. Tughlakabad Fort

8. The not so Famous “Bawadi” (water reservoir) close to Connaught Place. This place may interest some.

9. Jama Masjid – A very popular Mosque near Chandni Chowk.

Religious Places: (For foreign tourists – Please mind that when you go to any religious place you may see people donating money, People generally do it of their own will, Please don't give money to any one asking for it unless you buy your offerings from small kiosks at that particular place)

1. Lotus Temple – Beautiful Structure. Both in day and at night, this is also known as the Bahai temple does not belong to a particular religion all go here; you'll enjoy the silence here.

2. Gurudwara Sri Bangla Sahib – Close to Connaught Place, This is a very popular place of worship for Sikhs, is extremely crowded on Sundays, has a small pond full of fishes, Serves “Langar” (a free meal) in the day round the year that is open to all. I enjoy going here.

3. Chhatarpur Temple – Temple of Goddess “Adya Katyayani” is a Beautiful Structure (This is close to Qutub Minar, must visit if you go to Qutub Minar)

4. Birla Mandir (Mandir means Temple) – Close to Connaught Place – this is a famous temple for Tourists.

5. Sacred Heart Cathedral – Close to Connaught Place, This is a famous Catholic Church.

6. Jama Masjid – Mosque near Chandni Chowk

7. Iskon Temple – Near Lotus Temple, this temple is the temple to Lord Krishna and you will find a lot of foreigners as priests in this temple, a beautiful temple must visit if you see lotus temple.

8. Hanuman Mandir – Near Connaught Place – Temple to God Hanuman”

9. Bhairon Mandir – Near Pragati Maidan this is the temple to God Bhairon where The whisky is offered to God. – You will find a lot of Drunk beggars outside the Temple

Famous Markets – (RULE- bargain if you are not in a Shopping mall or you are not at a fixed price shop “FIXED PRICE” will be displayed at shop at the payment counter.)

1. Chandni Chowk – Try the Street Food also
2. Kamla Nagar – Though its very oily we Indians enjoy it, try Chahe Ke Chhole Bhature
3. Connaught Place – Must visit the inner circle, Janpath Street market, Central Cottage Emporium at Janpath (Janpath is the name of a Road, The bungalow of the prominent Congress Leader Sonia Gandhi and Rahul Gandhi is also here, the address is 10 Janpath), You can see India's first Air Conditioned Underground Market – Palika Bazaar, again dont forget to bargain big time may be start from 1/10th of the price first quoted.
4. Rajouri Garden – Expensive Fashion Street
5. Lajpat Nagar – Cheap Fashion Street
6. GK (Graiter Kailash) 1 and 2 both
7. Karol Bagh – Must Ghaffar Market bargain a lot
8. Khan Market – Expensive market with a lot of food joints, and I hope “Khan Chacha ke rolls” are available again to eat (a must)
9. South Extension both 1 and 2 – Expensive
10. Sarojini nagar – Cheap Fashion Street
