
Introduction: learning a new language

FUN METHOD: MI THEORY


FUN method is based on Howard Gardner's "Multiple Intelligences (MI) Theory. Gardner identifies Nine basic intelligences:

- 4. Body/ Kinesthetic


- 5. Musical /Rhythmic

Learning Writing though Scribbling

Writing is one of the four important skills of language learning.

It is an important aspect of language, and in this modern age of communication, Learning the skill to gain control over pen and put one's thoughts in the text form has become very essential.

Skills of Writing

Learning skills of writing a language is knowing perfectly about:

- 1. How to make strokes with proper hand movements.
- 2. How to make the right shapes of letters.
- 3. How to use vowels and vowel signs.
- 4. how to write in a natural, rhythmic and uniform way.

Scribbling method

Learner 's first day in the new is the same, as that of a toddler, and need child like curiosity, enthusiasm, and interest. To start with learning the new language through Art, the "Scribbling method 'is the best method to start with formation of new shapes and styles of new words.


The dictionary meaning of Scribble is: to write or draw hastily or carelessly without regard to legibility or form, the way toddler scribbled all over the paper.

Learning Writing: A Mechanical activity

Writing is a mechanical activity, and have to go through some important stages:

- 1. Pre-Writing Stage: Scribbling
- 2. Controlled Drawing Stage
- 3. Letter Writing ,Reading and Recognizing
- 4. Word Writing


Learning Phonetic skills: Phonetics

Each language has a unique system of sounds. The speech habits of the mother-tongue are likely to interfere with speech habits of new language (Hindi). The speech habits of mother tongue stands in the way of learning to pronounce Hindi correctly. Many letters of Hindi Alphabet have no corresponding sounds in English as well as other languages. The students of different linguistic zones find difficulties in acquiring right pronunciation in Hindi.

Hindi is a phonetic language, it is pronounced as it's is written. Pronunciation involves two interrelated skills:

- 1. Listening to and understanding the flow of speech
- Production of or fluency in speech
 It is only practice in listening and speaking which will give the learner the skills he require, that is correct hearing and production of correct sounds.
